Spaying and neutering are VERY important to us as an organization. Without spay and neuter initiatives, homeless animals will continue to overwhelm the rescue community, despite how hard we work at finding homes for them. Sterilization is critical for management of free-roaming dogs and cats and related disease control concerns. Because of this, we require that all dogs we adopt out be spayed/neutered. Typically, all our dogs and puppies are altered prior to being adopted out, but in some cases, we are unable to have a dog spayed or neutered prior to adoption.

***If a dog is unable to be spayed/neutered prior to adoption, SNARR Northeast requires adopters to provide proof of spay/neuter within 6 months of adoption, and in return we will refund \$125 of your dog's original adoption fee. (Failure to do so may result in SNARR Northeast revoking the adoption.) Do you agree to these terms?**

By answering the questions below, signing, and dating you are agreeing to all the terms and conditions of the S.N.A.R.R. Northeast Adoption Agreement below. We take our adoption contract very seriously and ask that you please do the same. Please read all details carefully before signing.

***1. Adopter agrees the dog is to be a family companion and agrees to provide the dog with a safe home, adequate food, water, proper care, exercise, love and attention. Adopter agrees not to violate any federal, state, or local laws or ordinances with the dog. The dog is not to be used as an attack or protection trained dog and will not be used for commercial guard work.**

***2. Adopter agrees to keep a buckle collar on the dog with ID tag, current rabies tag and town dog license. The dog is only to have a choke collar on during training and walks. If at any time the dog is lost, stolen, hurt or killed, the Adopter is to notify SNARR immediately via writing.**

***3. Adopter agrees that the dog will be confined inside the home when no one is at home. When the Adopter is to go away for a prolonged period of time or vacation, Adopter is to pre-arrange proper care for the dog.**

***4. The dog is not to ride loose in the bed of pickup trucks, convertibles or to be left in a car when air temperatures exceed 65 degrees.**

***5. Adopter agrees to have a clean, secure fenced area for the dog. If a fenced enclosure is not available, Adopter agrees to leash walk dog. If Adopter uses invisible fencing, the dog is to be sufficiently trained before releasing it inside the system. Under no circumstances is the dog to be kept routinely on a runner or tie out.**

***6. Adopter agrees to have the dog examined by a licensed veterinarian at least once each year and provide for all vaccinations and treatments necessary to ensure good health. If euthanasia becomes necessary as determined by a licensed veterinarian, Adopter agrees to have it performed by such a licensed veterinarian. Adopter agrees to give monthly Heartworm, flea and tick preventative medication.**

***8. SNARR makes no guarantees or statements regarding the dog's age, breed, health, or temperament. While SNARR made every effort to provide accurate history and assessment of the dog, we are not able to guarantee the dog's age, breed, medical status, behavior or disposition. No one can predict how any dog will react in a given situation, especially without complete knowledge of its background, as in the case with a rescued dog. The adopter(s) acknowledge this. Therefore, the adopter(s) are encouraged to exercise caution in introducing an adopted dog to new situations, family members, other pets, and visitors. The enthusiastic reactions of some children to dogs can often frighten the dog. It is strongly recommended that a responsible adult monitor the interaction between dogs and children at all times.**

There have not been nor can there be made explicit or implied guarantees or warranties regarding the temperament, behavior or physical condition either of the adopted dog or of its freedom from genetic defects. The dog is adopted "as is" and the adopter(s) assumes all responsibility for treatment of any and all existing conditions or any other conditions, physical or temperamental, that may occur.**

By signing this document electronically or physically, the signer, which shall also include all family members, all residents, and all occupants who share the domicile and/or residence of the signer, understands and agrees to Hold Harmless "SNARR Animal Rescue" and its associates from any and all Liabilities pertaining to the actions of the above mentioned dog. The below signed also acknowledges and accepts all the risks involved in the handling of this or any dog as "SNARR Animal Rescue" specifically makes no representations or guarantees, express or implied, as to the lack thereof of the dog(s)'(s) violent propensities.**

***12. SNARR is available for consultation, advice and assistance pertaining to the health, training and compatibility of the dog. If for whatever reason, including but not limited to: health reasons of the dog or Adopter, social reasons of the dog or Adopter, and issues of residency, the Adopter is unable to keep this dog for its entire life, the Adopter MUST return the dog to SNARR within 5 days of written demand to Adopter by SNARR. Furthermore, should Adopter wish to euthanize any dog for reasons due to health, sickness and/or age, prior to so doing, Adopter MUST first inform SNARR of same in writing. Should SNARR wish to obtain possession of the dog prior the euthanasia of same, Adopter must return the dog to SNARR within 5 days of written demand.**

If Adopter fails to return the dog within 5 days of written demand to Adopter, SNARR will seek a Court Order for return of the dog and seek liquidated damages from the Adopter in the amount of at least \$5,000.00 plus any court costs or attorney's fees. Payment of damages shall not excuse Adopter from returning the dog to SNARR.**

As a reminder:

- LISTED BREED(S) & AGE: We are taking our best guess on age, breed, and size when fully grown, based on the puppy's/dog's physical appearance and what we might have learned about one or both parents depending on the situation. *NOTE* We rarely know a dog's exact age, nor are we able to tell the true or full breed mix of dogs as our information is limited most of the time. Because we often do not have access to medical records at the time that we are listing for dogs for adoption, there are sometimes discrepancies between what is posted on their profile and what might be listed on a dog's medical records.
- MEETING ADOPTABLE DOGS: Meet and greets will not be scheduled until after your adoption application has been fully processed by one of our adoption processors.
